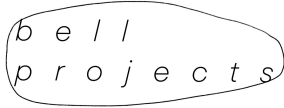

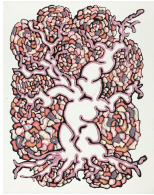
Bell Projects presents – **Fragmentary Elation** – a solo exhibition featuring work by **Camron Eidsness**. This exhibition opens Friday, January 7th and runs through January 23rd, 2022. Please join us for an opening reception on January 7th from 6pm until 10pm.

The mundane and bleak outlook on life that has accompanied much of the pandemic subsequently turned much of Eidsness's daily visual perception into a spectrum of gray. To counteract this feeling of isolation and banality, his natural reaction was to create loud, colorful pieces, which push themselves out into our reality, disrupting what was quickly becoming a dismal day-to-day existence. In order to combat the increasingly distant and virtual world we found (and continue to find) ourselves in, Eidsness also wanted to create a visually engaging and socially interactive series that is best viewed in person. As we see the canvases from a distance, we take in one image, but as we walk closer, we see many different cells composing the main piece. The many layers of gesso and acrylic create a textured surface on the canvas. This bas-relief effect is even more pronounced as the light changes throughout the day, highlighting different elements and details of the paintings depending on when you see them. Eidsness invites viewers to discover the many layers and fragments these paintings contain by moving around them and taking time to notice the colors and textures.

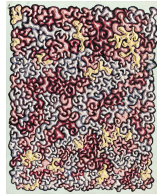
Raised in Colorado, **Camron Eidsness** spent much of his adolescence in the Western Slope until moving to Denver 12 years ago. He lives downtown, working as a vintner during the day and spends most of his free time painting and experimenting with unusual composites of acrylic-based paints as well as developing his own painting utensils. Only working with primaries, each color on canvas is blended individually, making no two colors alike in any of his pieces.

Bell Projects seeks to support local artists and their work by curating and presenting exhibitions on a monthly basis in their gallery space located at 2822 E. 17th Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80206. All exhibitions are free to attend and are open to the public.

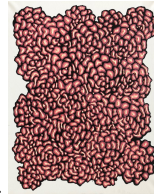

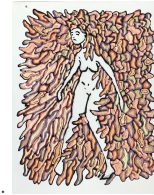

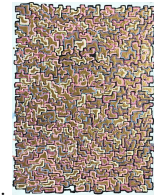

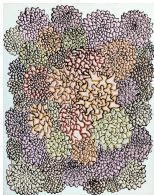

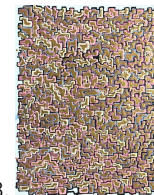

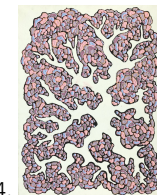
